CORONATION BUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions will make teddy bear size bunting. Increase the sizes for larger bunting.

- Materials Required: Strips of paper 2" wide by 12" long - we used various patterned paper as well as plain red, white and blue Pencil Ruler Hole Punch Coloured Twine
- 2. Using the pencil and ruler, mark a strip of paper every 2" along the length on one edge. On the opposite edge, start at 1" and then mark every 2" along the length.



3. Now, using the pencil draw a diagonal line joining each of the marks you have made as shown below. Use the ruler to make sure your lines are straight.



4. Cut out each of the subsequent triangular shapes. There will be some wastage at each end.



5. Now mark holes at each corner of the wide edge of each triangle.



6. Use the hole punch to punch out the holes from the triangles. Ensure that you stay inside the edges of the triangles.



7. Thread the twine through each triangle in turn, making sure that you thread it through from the back, to the front each time, as shown below.





8. Your completed bunting should now look like that shown below. You can make your bunting as long as you like just by adding in extra triangles.
